THE SHORT HISTORY OF OUR SCHOOL

The school opened in 1963 on the first day of September. At that time, schools did not have names, they were numbered. Our school was called „Primary School Number 6”. In 1963 there was a teacher, Kisgyörgy István, who did not like the idea of schools being numbered. He decided to call Mr. Marjalaki Kis Lajos to help him choose a name for the school. On that unknown day, when this call happened, the school got the name „Fazekas” („Potter”), after the street where the school is located.



The institution nowadays and the school choir

Our school is very well known in the city, it has a really good reputation because of the great art education. I will introduce all the courses.

The oldest, and the most famous one is the Fazekas Children's Choir. The choir started in the same year as the school opened, in 1963. The conductor of the choir has been Mrs Balás since 2008. She has got two awards for her amazing job: Reményi Ede Musical Award and Artisjus Award. She is still leading the choir, which has been really successful over the past decades.

Students usually start in the Fazekas Little Choir, and then, after they are in fifth grade, they start singing in the big choir.





Dance courses

Our students have so many opportunities, one of them is dancing. They can choose folk dance and modern dance as well.

There are two classes a week, they are usually one hour and 45 minute long classes. At the end of the year, children take an exam to show their dance skills and enjoy a good time on stage.

Musical courses

There is a lot of choices in musical courses. Students can attend the afternoon classes after their normal lessons. The length of the lessons are usually 30 minutes or an hour. The children take a mid-term and an end of year exam to show their skills and get grades. Students participate in competitions during the year, and they achieve excellent awards.
